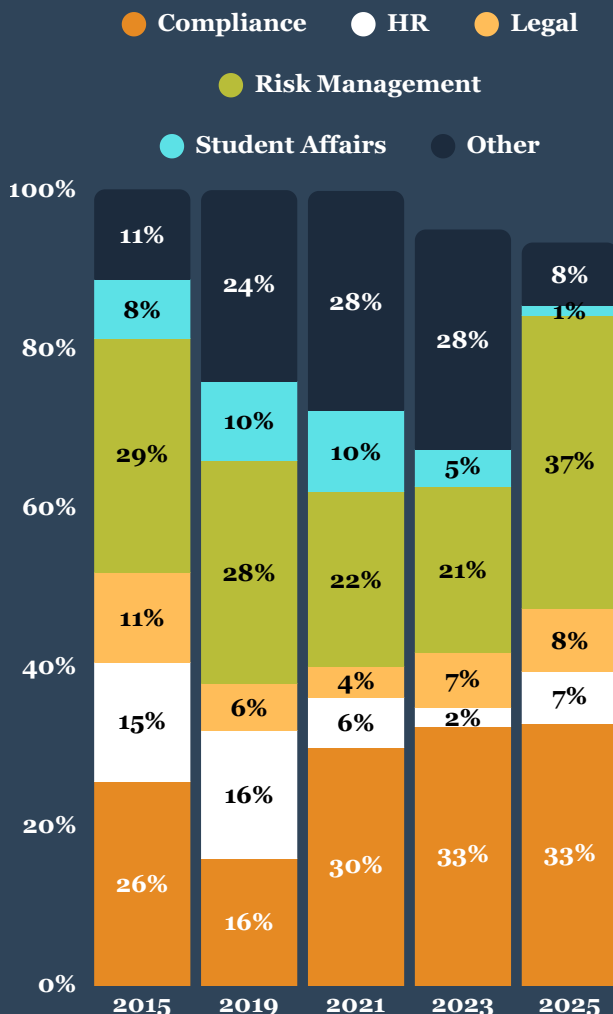
Training requirement has increased by 10% and now is required in policies 96% of the time

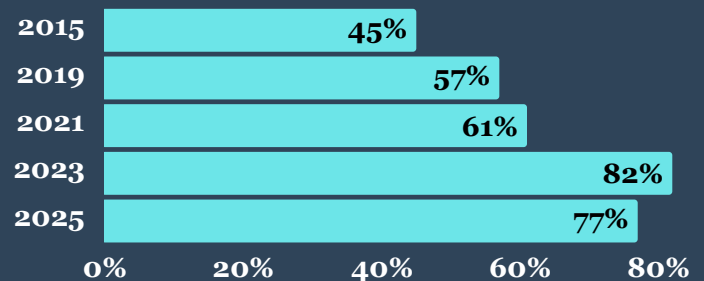
